GUILFORD "SPRING THEME" WINDOW PAINTING AROUND THE GREEN

Permission/Participation Form

Contest is open to Guilford youth in grades 5-8. Artists may enter individually or in a group of up to 4 members. Artists will be accepted to participate until the contest is full.

The window painting contest will take place on March 10th (Raindate: March 11th) between 11:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. All participants who have been selected to participate will meet on the Guilford Green across from Town Hall at 11:00 a.m.

Participants will be required to provide a "family friendly" sketch to Karolin Regan by March 7th. All supplies will be provided by D.A.Y., participants are not allowed to use anything on the windows other than what is provided by D.A.Y. members on the day of the event.

Upon receiving their supplies, artists will receive an index card with the name of the business and the number of the window they will be painting. All artwork will be painted at the height of which the children can reach (no ladders!). Each window being painted must be supervised by a parent of one of the artists. However, parents are not allowed to assist the youths in the painting!

Each artist must be available on March 24th (Raindate: March 25th) at 10:00 a.m. to return to the green for a celebration of the event identifying the first place winners of each grade, as well as the winner who has the most creative display of friendship or community! After the celebration artists will be required to remove the paint from the windows (supplies will be provided!).
