BEACH RULES

1. No smoking/tobacco on beach area, under pavilions, or on playground.
2. No boats or flotation devices. This includes tubes, rubber boats, swimmies, air mattresses, and personal flotation devices
3. All swimmers must stay in the swim area.
4. Unnecessary rough play will not be tolerated.
5. No fishing in the beach area.
6. No snorkels or scuba equipment in the swim area.
7. All swimmers must wear swimsuits.
8. No swimmers in long pants.
9. Please carry out all litter.
10. No glass in beach area.
11. Buses must get a permit from the Parks & Recreation Department.
12. The Parks & Recreation Department reserves the right to close the beaches due to weather conditions or overcrowding.
13. Beaches close at dusk or at times posted by the Parks & Recreation Department.
14. An adult must closely supervise all children.
15. Swimming is allowed only when a lifeguard is on duty.
16. No dogs allowed on beach without a leash.
17. No golfing.
18. No one may walk on the jetty or rocks at Jacobs Beach.
19. Hanging on to ropes at Lake Quonnipaug is not allowed except in an emergency.
20. No playing with Frisbees, balls, etc. in the beach area at Lake Quonnipaug.
